Text Structure and Organisation

- Group information together into sections

Use simple organisational devices to aid presentation in non-fiction writing (headings and subheadings)

Punctuation:

Use capital letters for:

- o the personal pronoun I
- o the beginning of sentence
- o names of people and places
- o days of the week
- Use question marks
- Use commas in lists
- Use exclamation marks
- Use apostrophes for omission Begin to use apostrophes to show singular possession



Plan writing by:

- Planning or saying out loud what they are going to write about
- Writing down ideas/keywords including new vocabulary
- Use expanded noun phrases for description and specification
- Use adverbs within sentences
- Use more adventurous vocabulary choices to add detail

Evaluate writing by:

- Re-reading to check their writing makes sense and tense is correct
- Proof-read to check for errors in spelling, punctuation and grammar
