MATHS

In maths this half term, we will be looking at addition and subtraction. The children will use column methods to add and subtract numbers for up to three digits.

Numbers to 10000- recognise that 10 hundreds is equal to 1 thousand and 1000 is 10 times the size of 100. Recognise the place value of each digit in a four-digit number. Partition numbers.

ENGLISH

In English, we will use texts- Ocean Meets Sky by Terry Fan.

The children will write narratives. They will identify the different stages of a narrative and then will plan and write their own. They will write using varied vocabulary and sentence structure.

Write recounts. The children will write recounts in first person. They will use expanded noun phrases to add description and time adverbials of time.

READING

We will read our colour banded reading books each day in groups. We will be reading ocean meets sky. We will also be enjoying our 3pm read sharing a book picked by a different child each day

DT- Design a communications device suitable for the Evil Genius.
