Howletch Lane Primary School Breakfast Club is inclusive and fun, providing a stimulating social environment for children to start their school day. The club promotes healthy eating and gives children the opportunity to make confident choices about a balanced diet.



The Breakfast Club runs Monday to Friday, term time only, from **7.45 am until 8.50 am.** The children are then taken to their classroom before registration.
Children are welcome at any time after **7.45 am**; breakfast will be available up until 8.20 am.

Parents can gain access by pressing the bell marked 'Breakfast club' at the door which leads into the KS2 Hall. There is a sign pointing to the room, Children must be accompanied until breakfast club staff take the child/children in.



What We Offer

We offer fruit, cereals, toast and to drink, water, fruit juice or milk. We are able to cater for children with food allergies. Please make sure our school office are aware of any allergies or intolerances your child may have.

Sessions must be booked and paid for at least one day in advance at the school office and paid for using Arbor (guidance can be found on the school website).
