We will working with numbers to 1000. To know 10 tens are equivalent to 100. To work out how many 10's there are in a three digit number.

To recognise place value of each digit in a three digit number.

Place three digit numbers on a number line.

Secure place value to 100 applying addition and subtraction.

Bridging 100 counting on and back in 10's, adding and subtracting multiples of 10.

# RE
