RE

Why do Christians call Jesus the 'Light of the World'? Pupils will describe Christian beliefs shown in the Christmas story. Pupils will describe Christian belief in Jesus as light, Son of God and saviour, they will have the opportunity to look at some images which depict Jesus as light of the world and suggest meaning of the imagery. They will learn about the Advent ring and its significance for Christians. They will reflect on their own and others' experiences and ideas. They will consider whether the Christmas story has anything to say to people today.

ENGLISH

In English, we are going to read *Julia Donaldson Zog and Jonty Gentoo*.

We will tell a three part story about a central character.

We will add additional character description.

We will write simple instructions about something we know well. We will include verbs and use precise language and commands.
