ENGLISH

In English, we will be looking at the book The Butterfly Lion this half term. This book will be the focus of our English lessons. The children will write a narrative. The children will focus on adverbial phrases and pronouns in their narrative. The children will also write an explanation text in their English lessons. In English the children will continue to develop their understanding of punctuation and grammar.

READING

The children will complete a 30 minute reading session each day. The children will answer a variety of questions based on what they have read. We will also be enjoying our 3pm read sharing a book picked by a different child each day.
