

MATHS

This half term, Year 6 will continue to work on their recall and fluency strategies daily. We will complete daily times table challenges to solidify learning as well as extra reasoning and problem solving challenges.

During this half term we will learn more about percentages, the order of operations and ratio (all in preparation for our SATs)

PE

Year 6 will be doing Athletics this half term; running, jumping, throwing and catching in isolation and in combination.

RE

This half term we will be exploring Christianity and the themes surrounding the Easter story.

ENGLISH

In English, we will be focusing our reading around 'The Nowhere Emporium' by Ross Mackenzie. The book will be the focus of our English lessons where we will explore features including figurative language, relative clauses and conjunctions. We will be completing a range of written tasks such as a narrative and a discussion text. Children will continue to recap and improve their understanding of spelling, punctuation and grammar.

READING

Year 6 will have a daily, 30-minute, reading session. In groups, they will explore the class text, read aloud, answer a variety of questions with reference to prediction, summarising, inference and understanding of vocabulary.

LMTW Wars of the World This unit teaches the following subjects:

Wars of the World is based on conflicts past and present, with a key focus on history and geography.

History – know and understand why wars occur, learn about the two world wars, understand a civil war and the concept of peace.

Geography – to know where current wars are taking place

Science – understand that light appears to travel in straight lines, light travels from light sources, why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them

Art – join fabrics in different ways, including stitching

Design Technology – Design, make and evaluate a device to send morse code signals. Ask the pupils to write short messages and see if the class can work them out.

Music – explore wartime songs, playing musical instruments with increasing accuracy, fluency, control and expression

PSHE – recognise when a friendship is making them feel unhappy or uncomfortable, to know different types of bullying, to know how to recognise when a relationship is harmful

ICT/Computing – know how to use design software to create a poster
